FAITHFUL AMBASSADOR

God and man safely trust the faithful ones. Faithful people have divine attraction. Our Epaphroditus was a guiding light to us even in this. He was a faithful messenger to the church of Macedonia. That is why the entire church decided to send him as their ambassador. They gave all their willing offerings for Paul to this faithful man. When the church heard that their founding apostle Paul was in prison facing death, they couldn't bear it. It was a thankful and faithful church. They remembered all the sufferings Paul underwent when he came first time to them with the Gospel of God (Ac.16:22-24). They thankfully remembered his life-giving ministry for them. I can see their heartfelt tears for Paul.

If Paul had not brought them the Gospel, where would they be? Without seeing the glorious Gospel, they all would have groped in darkness and shadow of death. Their gratefulness turned into great generosity. Out of their deep poverty and great affliction, they gave a liberal offering with abundance of joy. That money was sent to Paul as a sweet smelling aroma through the hands of Epaphroditus.

Gift of Liberality

Let me say something here about the gift of giving. You need not be rich and wealthy to give to God liberally. In all the years of my ministry I have seen that some rich people are extremely stingy and some poor people are extremely generous.

Giving to God has nothing to do with your money, but it has everything to do with your heart and mind. Generosity is one of the noblest virtues of Christian life. Paul called it "the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia". It is one of the grace gifts (charismata) of the Holy Spirit (2.Co.8:1). Liberal giving is also one of God's special ministry callings (Ro.12:6-8). People with this special gift of grace give even out of their deep poverty. They abound in the riches of their liberality. They are living examples to us all and just enjoy giving.

Poor widow

Jesus commended the poor widow who gave all her livelihood out of her poverty. To give generously and cheerfully according to what one has, not according to what one does not have, is a great blessing (2.Co.8:12). That is why God selected a poor widow to feed His servant Elijah. If I was God, I would have sent Elijah to the house of a millionaire, not to a poor widow. She was struggling even to provide her own last meal. If I was Elijah, I would have given her some money and left her.

Thank God, Elijah was utterly obedient to God and unashamedly asked her for a little bread for himself. Do you know why? After all, he was not asking for himself. He knew God as His Source and knew His God would feed him anyway. As a prophet, though, he knew how God would bless and feed her entire family if she would just give to him her last meal. Paul had this same attitude toward the Macedonians. He didn't seek their gift, but that their fruit might abound in their account; so he gladly accepted the generous offerings of that poverty-stricken church.

Dear friends, it is your duty to generously support your ministers who blessed you in any way. That will increase your heavenly account. He will surely supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Phil.4:19). It will be a blessing for you not only to give from your money but also to collect funds to support God's ministers. You can give your physical help along with your money. God will never forget such sacrifices. He will surely honor you as He publicly honored His servant Epaphroditus.

It was this thankful generous attitude that motivated the church and Epaphroditus to support Paul even financially. Paul established many churches but no church shared with him concerning giving and receiving except Macedonia. This filled Paul's heart with thankfulness towards them. He remembered how they helped him for his necessities. It greatly comforted this prisoner's heart (Phil.4:15-18).

I infer Epaphroditus and his church might have organized a prayer time especially for Paul, and the Spirit of God would have stirred their hearts. All of them saw two great needs for Paul. One was for someone to go and personally help the lonely Paul who suffered in the prison. Such a person had to be extremely selfless, willing to suffer and even die with him.

Another need they saw was for financial help for Paul. They looked for the most faithful man with whom they could send their money. To meet both needs, the only person they could find was Epaphroditus.

To send Epaphroditus to Paul was a great sacrifice to the Church as they were attached to him. It was like giving their own eyes to the leader who blessed them uniquely. The whole church knew they were debtors to Paul and had to help him in his days of great need. Could the entire church visit Paul? The only option for them was to send their most beloved Epaphroditus (Phil.2:30).

Epaphroditus gladly accepted this sacrificial service. I can see it was a great sacrifice for him also to leave his beloved church. He was well aware that joining Paul was like joining a group of suicide bombers. As a faithful representative of His church, he went to Paul with a bag full of money. What more proof do we need to know him as a faithful steward?

Responsible people must be extremely trustworthy. Epaphroditus was entrusted with such a noble privilege as of taking care of Paul in his sufferings. They trusted his honesty to deal with God's finances. This is the trait of a true ambassador. The Early Church was not gullible to trust everybody easily. Before they gave their wealth to someone, they thoroughly tested his honesty and sincerity.

Leaders'longing

If you move with leaders, you will find out one common thing in all of them. All these leaders are disappointed with dishonest helpers and therefore struggle to trust people. It is easier for them to get talented and able people than to get faithful people. That's why Paul writes, "the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also" (2.Tim.2:2).

Faithful men will not betray their leader. They don't talk one thing to him and a different thing to others. They dare not break their leader's trust. They are not backbiters. They are extremely loyal to carry out their responsibilities, even risking their very lives for it.

The Early Church leaders collected much money for the poor churches and carefully selected faithful people to entrust them with that money. See how diligent and careful they were to find stewards: "We have sent with them our brother whom we have often proved diligent in many things, but now much more diligent, because of the great confidence which we have in vou" (2.Co.8:22). See! They often proved before trusting people with money. We can see this principle all throughout the Bible.

After serving God in leadership position for many years, I only give responsibilities to faithful people. My heart refuses to give positions only based on talents, abilities and gifts. I can see the heart of God and His leaders.

Jethro

God gave a beautiful counsel to Moses through his

father-in-law Jethro. "Moreover you shall select from all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of ten" (Ex.18:21). Ability alone is definitely not enough. The fear of God as well as truthfulness and hating covetousness are extremely needed along with their abilities. Such people are ordained as leaders. This is God's method.

Alas! There is no scarcity of talented and able men today but there is a terrible scarcity of faithful men of sacrifice and self denial. Epaphroditus shone like a bright star in the midst of dense darkness.

Nehemiah

The leader Nehemiah's wisdom is exemplary. He appointed treasurers over the storehouses. "...they were considered faithful, and their task was to distribute to their brethren" (Neh.13:13). He clearly shows from his writing whom to trust with such distribution tasks.

As Epaphroditus proved his faithfulness, the Early Church trusted him with their liberal funds.

Where are the givers

There is mountainous financial need for God's servants today. Wicked and sinful people indulge in extreme wealth and freely give money to spread filth and sin. God's anointed faithful servants suffer one financial crisis after the other, unable to do what they want to do for the Lord.

Filthy pornographic literature is sold in millions and billions. How much more should anointed books spread! How much more money is needed to print millions of copies! The mass media and the telecommunication world are spitting sin and violence all over the world. How much more should we use the media to bless the entire world with our purifying message!

Where will God's ministers go for such huge money? Do God's servants live in abundance today? Of course, every servant of God must learn to be abased and to abound, but still they must enjoy God's prosperity. Who will meet their financial needs? Where are the faithful, generous leaders who challenge their churches and bring huge offerings to the men of God, as a sweet smelling fragrance to meet their enormous needs? Where are the Macedonian churches? Who will happily and freely give according to their ability and even beyond their ability (2.Co.8:2-3)?

Paul received the Macedonian offering gladly as an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God. He felt so full of joy in his heart that he lavishly blessed the church with the promise from Philippians 4:17: "And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

I remember Isaac who blessed his son after eating his favorite food. When God's servants enjoy the fullness, they spontaneously bestow their blessings upon the giver. Paul was overwhelmed with such joy about it and wrote gladly about **Epaphroditus: "...for the work of Christ he came close to death, not regarding his life, to supply what was lacking in your service toward me"** (Phil.2:30). Can your leaders praise you like this?

God is willing to use the generous and liberal givers. He is seeking the people who give themselves to the Lord and to God's leaders. Blessings are fully released to those who give out of their deep poverty with extreme liberality.

Paul quotes the Macedonian church as a model for generosity (2.Co.11:9). Still there is a need for such role models for generosity. In these last days the work of God must accelerate in an unimaginable speed. This needs enormous money.

Those who refresh

To meet these enormous financial needs, generous givers must rise up to sponsor and to support God's true works. It is our duty. God's ministers have sown spiritual things for you. Is it a great thing if they reap your material things (1.Co.9:11)? God very specifically commands His people, "let him who is taught the word share in all good things with him who teaches" (Gal.6:6).

The ambassador Epaphroditus brought great refreshing to the heart of Paul. Paul writes about it,

"Indeed I have all and abound. I am full, having received from Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you" (Phil.4:18). A faithful ambassador soothes the heart of everyone. "Like the cold of snow in time of harvest is a faithful messenger to those who send him, for he refreshes the soul of his masters" (Pr.25:13).

Truly Epaphroditus was a cold snow in summer. He refreshed the heart of his leader Paul. Dear friend, will you be such a responsible and trustworthy ambassador for God and His people? Will you be faithful in your financial dealings? Will you allow the Holy Spirit to transform you day by day?

Serving ambassador

Paul commends Epaphroditus for yet another important aspect. He says he supplied what was lacking to Paul. This is one of the noble virtues of Epaphroditus. He was a spiritual leader to his church but a humble servant to his leader. He was an apostle on one side and a faithful attendant to Paul on the other side. He was faithful in both commitments, in being a leader and in being a servant.

Every servant must fulfill these two ministries. One cannot be a leader for all in all places. Maybe God has made you a leader for a group. That is good, but

you must also have your leader. For that leader, you function as an assistant. This is one of the Bible principles for every leader. This is the ministry Epaphroditus rendered to his leader Paul. The apostle Epaphroditus collected the money and journeyed a long distance to Paul. He committed himself as Paul's faithful deacon, supplying what was lacking in service to Paul.

I do not know in what way Epaphroditus ministered to Paul's need. Did he cook Paul's favorite food for him? Did he give him a massage for his weary body? Did he pour water on his hands like Elisha? Did he run errands at Paul's bidding as Joshua did to Moses? Did he intercede for him night and day? Did he go shopping to purchase for his needs? Did he take his hand and walk with his aged leader? Did he wash his clothes? I do not know. All I know is that he served Paul as a good helper and was a great consolation to his leader's heart. He even went near to death in his service to Paul. Wow!

Beloved, every mighty servant of God you see today was once a faithful servant to his leaders. Never forget this principle of leadership.

God's leaders freely delegate their responsibilities to such trusted, faithful helpers. God honors such fellow laborers in due time. The ministry needs gifted and powerful people. I believe it with all my heart. Ministry without miracles and gifts of the Spirit is like travelling by bicycle. Ministry with signs and wonders is like travelling in a jet plane. We must covet the gifts of the Spirit as never before.

In all this, we must constantly pursue love and a godly character. A gifted person without character is like a cancer patient travelling in the jet plane. Can I ask you a question? Will your leader testify about you as "the one who ministered to my need, and the one who supplied what was lacking in your service toward me" (Phil.2:25,30)? Will you be a faithful fellow laborer, fellow soldier and God's messenger to your leader?

God seeks truthfulness in your heart. God's leaders are seeking faithful co-workers. God's church needs faithful men as strong pillars. Truthfulness is attractive. Will you adorn yourself with this beauty and live as an attractive man, an attractive woman of God?

Are you a successful spouse?

What can you expect from your spouse? First of all, we need to understand what we should can rightfully expect from our spouse. I have found that many of the reasons why people are unhappy, frustrated, discontent and quarrelsome in their marriages simply have their root in a basic misunderstanding of the specific role the spouse is supposed to fulfill.

If we don't understand God's wise creation, we expect our spouse to think, feel and act as we do. This goes so far that marriage polls have shown women to describe the attributes of another woman when asked for their idea of a perfect husband. Of course, this is not God's idea! It shows only the struggle these women have with understanding God's purposes. In order to find out whether your spouse is a successful spouse, we need to look at God's requirements for his or her gender. You can also check yourself as to whether you would be considered a successful spouse once you stand before your Creator. Many people had big surprises and changed their attitudes toward each other fundamentally when they understood this truth.

What is a successful husband?

Since the whole idea of marriage comes from God, the question to ask here is actually, "What does God expect from a husband?" In any area of life, fulfilling His requirements is real success. As we have seen, Adam was created for a job. He is a man on a mission. He had already been given great responsibilities like naming all the animals

before Eve was even created. He lived in closest fellowship with his loving Father God and enjoyed exercising full authority over the Garden of Eden and everything in it.

It is probably this work-mindedness that made God to command men especially to "love their wives, just as Christ also loved the Church and gave Himself for her" (Eph.5:25). A man can focus so much on his career, his job and other tasks that he can easily forget this most important, Godgiven requirement for a happy marriage and family life.

As husbands and fathers, men are supposed to love their wives and to be their protectors and providers. If your husband endeavors to fulfill these roles to the best of his abilities, he is a successful husband in God's eyes. Here again, the principle from 2nd Corinthians 8:12 applies: "For if there is first a willing mind, it is accepted according to what one has, and not according to what he does not have". Of course, God does expect all of us to grow and improve, but He makes sure we can also fulfill the good desire He puts into our hearts if we allow Him (1.Co.4:1-4; Phil.1:6):

...for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure (Phil.2:13)

Dear sister, a happy marriage for you is God's good pleasure. Therefore, He Himself will work on your husband's heart if you ask Him to do so. You might have many more desires and demands toward your husband, like more romance, more

understanding or other things. Yes, I agree, we should both endeavor to understand each other more deeply every day, but this is a special bonus, a beautiful overflow from a loving relationship. Many women make the mistake of constantly nagging, complaining and accusing their husbands for not giving them the "bonus" instead of first showing gratitude that they fulfill God's primary demand. Dear sister, once you become grateful and satisfied with his attempts to show his love to you by providing for you and protecting you, he will automatically desire to do much more for you. Your appreciation for what he does now is his greatest encouragement to become what you desire him to be! Your appreciation makes him desire to please you more. The rest is automatic. The peaceful, joyful atmosphere this appreciation creates will be a healing balm not only for your marriage and your children, but also for your physical bodies. How simple and easy are God's ways! Truly, His commandments are not burdensome, and His voke is easy (1.Jn.5:3; Mt.11:30).

What is a successful wife?

Here again, we need to ask, "What does God expect from a wife?" Well, Eve was created as a remedy for Adam's loneliness, as a "helper comparable to him" (Ge.2:18). Note here: the wife was supposed to be a helper, not a teacher or commander! A comparable helper is a wife who endeavours to learn and understand her husband's job as well as his likes and dislikes. She is a woman who does her best to support him, build him up and inspire others to honor him. She is a woman who submits happily and without grumbling to her husband's loving leadership. If in anything she has a different opinion and suffers because of it, she entrusts her soul to her faithful Creator and keeps doing good to her husband and her society (1.Pe.4:19). She is, however, not a weakling to endure harassment but a noble, dignified personality whose sole appearance commands respect. Take the time to study Proverbs 33:10-31! She will not allow her body which is the holy temple of God's Holy Spirit to be abused and tortured. She will obey her husband

"in the Lord", which means, not against God's clear instructions.

Please take the time to study Proverbs 33:10-31! This powerful, successful wife manages an entire household with maids and servants, makes and sells clothes, and buys fields, but she is very careful to honor her husband and to make him appear honorable before others. See God's beautiful description:

- 10 Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies.
- 11 The heart of her husband safely trusts her; so he will have no lack of gain.
- 12 She does him good and not evil all the days of her life (Pr.31:10-12)


Actually, God's very special command to wives is, "let the wife see that she respects her husband" (Eph.5:33). A wife who honors her husband not only in her behavior but even in her thought life and actively rejects any temptation to criticize or even despise her husband, a wife who understands that submission is for her protection, is a successful wife in God's eyes.

Dear husband, dear wife, no matter what is your complaint, please measure your spouse and also yourself by God's standards. Be careful not to expect things outside of God's "job description" for husbands and wives. Begin by being grateful for what he or she already does, and encourage each other to keep growing into your God-given roles. By doing this, you will together attain the fullness of God's plan for a married couple.
